To complete the Honors Program you will need to take three Honors Sections and three Honors Seminars. Seminars are usually taken during the junior and senior years, so they do not present a significant obstacle to first - or second -year students who join the program.

Honors Sections, involve general requirements, many of which you will have completed by the end of the current semester. To find out if you have room in your degree, complete the checklist on this page. If you have not taken three or more courses listed, then you can likely complete the requirements of the Honors Program.
